

Tournament Refund Policy

Williamsburg Invitational Memorial Day



For weather related cancellations, please read the policy below.

For any other cancellation reasons, the tournament committee will meet to discuss expenses before announcing refund/credits to teams.

New for 2025, there is an option of purchasing Event Cancellation Insurance for your team's entry fee into our event through GotSport.

For teams that purchase Event Cancellation Insurance here is how it works:

Full Refund for Pre-Tournament Cancellations:

If the event is canceled before the tournament starts due to weather conditions, your insured team will receive 100% of the non-refundable registration fee back. No questions asked.

Pro-Rated Refund for Mid-Tournament Cancellations:

In the event that the tournament is forced to cancel after it has started due to weather conditions, the insured team will receive a refund based on the number of games guaranteed versus the number of games played. This ensures you only pay for the games you've played and not a penny more.

Affordable Protection at Just 10% of the Entry Fee

Adding Event Cancellation Team Coverage to your registration is a smart choice for safeguarding against the unexpected. Don't let the possibility of weather-related cancellations disrupt your team's plans or financial commitments.

Event Cancellation Insurance can be purchased up to 14 days prior to the event kickoff date. For teams that want to purchase Event Insurance after registration, <u>click this link for instructions.</u>

Entry Fee Example: \$900

- Insurance will cost \$90
- Event Fully Cancelled due to weather:
 - Your team receives a \$900 refund from USSCI

- Event Cancelled due to weather, and you only received 2 games:
 - Your team receives a \$300 refund from USSCI

For teams that DO NOT purchase Event Cancellation Insurance, here is the weather cancellation refund policy:

In the event that inclement weather forces the cancellation of all or part of the tournament, the Tournament Staff will communicate all refund/credit options to affected teams as quickly as possible after the tournament weekend.
